Land Surveys between 4th and 7th Streets along Townsend Street and within Caltrain Station Tracks

This important work is part of the Transbay Joint Powers Authority's (TJPA) Downtown Rail Extension (DTX) project, now also known as The Portal, to extend Caltrain commuter rail from its current terminus at Fourth and King streets and bring blended California High-Speed Rail service to the TJPA's Salesforce Transit Center in downtown San Francisco.

What?

The TJPA through its subcontractor, Parsons / Chaudhary & Associates, will be conducting land surveys between 4th and 7th Streets along Townsend Street and within Caltrain and King Station to map existing conditions for the design of the DTX project.

Where?

Work will take place between 4th and 7th Streets along Townsend Street and within the Caltrain Fourth and King Station.

When and What Time?

The survey work will begin Monday, April 3, 2023 and conclude on April 28, 2023, with expected work hours from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

(Note: Due to unforeseen circumstances, this schedule may be subject to change without notice.)

What Does This Mean to You?

- There may be survey crews set up with a tripod in bike lanes or sidewalks, which may be temporarily un-usable while surveyors are taking measurements.
- Traffic control will be provided where the work encroaches traffic lanes.

What Can You Expect?

A Survey crew of up to three individuals may be present with survey equipment and support vehicles such as Pickup Truck / Passenger Vehicle.

What is Land Surveying?

Land surveying includes surveying of areas for their correct determination and description and for conveyancing, or for the establishment or reestablishment of land boundaries and the plotting of lands and subdivisions.
