

Gridlines 1 to 10


Central Zone
Gridlines 10 to 20


Eastern Zone

Western Zone (GL 1-10)

- Rooftop restaurant walls and decks concrete continues.
- W1 Exterior Awning is now completed except infill adjacent to the Bus Ramp.
- Metal stud framing of walls, gyp board, MEP rough—in and Curtain wall systems installation continues.
- Escalator and Elevator construction is well underway in all zones.
- Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing/Fire Sprinkler (MEPF) installation continues.
- Main electric switchgear and transformer room buildout is in progress and being readied for energization.
- Concrete Masonry Unit wall installation nearing completion.



Central Zone (GL 10-20)

- Rooftop landscaping trees, underground conduit, piping and fountain precast is now underway on both north and south sides.
- Rooftop glass canopy over escalator 407/408 glazing has started.
- Rooftop and Bus Deck seismic joint installation is in progress.
- Metal stud framing of walls and soffits, gyp board and curtain wall systems installation continuing.
- All levels continue with MEPF systems installation.
- Main electric switchgear and transformer rooms buildout in progress and being readied for energization.
- First Street temporary bridge removal is complete and was reopened late February.








Eastern Zone (GL 20-35)

- Light Column "Oculus" Skylight glazing panels and glass floor are complete.
- Rooftop waterproofing continues (weather permitting).
- Rooftop Café forming of walls has started and is on-track.
- Bus Deck concrete drive aisle and pedestrian island near completion.
- All levels now have metal stud framing of walls, gyp board, MEP rough-in and curtain wall systems installation underway.
- MEPF systems installation and testing continues at all levels.
- W1 Exterior Awning installation now in progress east of Fremont street.






Bus Ramp Bridge

- Bridge drop-in steel assembly spanning connection to Transit Center is now installed.
- Cable Stay Bridge contractor (VSL) re-mobilizing in March.
- Security Guard Booth is now installed on the Bus Ramp.
- Viaduct electrical utility work continues on the Bus Ramp.
- Viaduct Falsework removal is now complete under Clementina with Harrison removal March 3rd - 5th.
- Underground wet utility work continues including connections to City systems.
- Earthwork final grading is now in progress near I-80 at the West Approach.






BSF Project Location

Scope of Work

- AC Transit Administration Building approximately 1,500 sf
- Support Building approximately 900 sf
- Guard Booth 50 sf
- Site Excavation/Off-haul
- Paving/Grading
- Perimeter Sound Walls/Fencing
- Bus Link Ramp connecting the Bus Storage Facility to the Bus Ramp
- Utility Work: plumbing, fire sprinkler, gas, electrical, communication, and sewer services for the buildings as well as site lighting, security, and CCTV systems



Scope of Work

Alternates/Allowance:

- A1 All costs to load, transport, and dispose of site material classified as Class I RCRA Hazardous Waste. Estimated quantity is 200 tons.
- A2 All costs to load, transport, and dispose of site material classified as Class I non-RCRA Hazardous Waste. Estimated quantity is 3,200 tons.
- A3 All costs to load, transport, and dispose of site material classified as Class II Hazardous Waste. Estimated quantity is 3,000 tons.
- **A4** Allowance for TJPA's use: San Francisco Police Department Traffic control. Lump sum value of \$10,000.





Recovery Schedule continues to hold while Schedule tightness continues to represent risk to project.

Active Management

- 1. All Major Activities treated as Critical
- 2. Project Leadership Team encouraging early issue elevation
- 3. Continually seeking early warning of next challenge on the horizon

Recent Actions

- 1. Re-sequenced Temporary Bridge Removals proceeding well.
- 2. Project Leadership issue resolution forum continues to readily address issues that have been elevated such as previously languishing electrical, lighting and landscape related product submittals or shop drawings threating schedule.
