



Welcome to the Transbay Transit Center Project! The construction site is an exciting place to learn about the significant progress that has been made toward completion of the new “Grand Central of the West.” Safety is our top priority at all times. Please read the information below and carefully follow all instructions.

As we move quickly towards substantial completion, daily construction activities continue to intensify. As a result, TJPA will no longer be able to provide large group tours of the construction site. However, there may be small group site visits allowed after construction activity slows in the afternoons. Large group tours may be accommodated with a presentation and a site perimeter tour.

**Location:** The presentation and safety briefing will take place at 201 Mission Street, Suite 2100. You will be escorted onto the construction site by a construction tour guide.

**Transportation:** Our office is located on the corner of Mission and Beale Street. We encourage guests to walk, bike, take a taxi or take Muni to the event. Our building is centrally located near several transit centers including the Temporary Transbay Terminal and the Embarcadero BART station. **Parking:** Event parking will **not** be available. Metered street parking is limited in neighboring blocks. Some parking lots and garages are within walking distance.

***All visitors must wear appropriate foot protection when entering our construction site, including boots or hard leather shoes, hard hats, reflective safety vests and safety glasses.***

**SAFETY:** Due to safety requirements and capacity limitations, attendance is limited to invited guests only and all visitors must be accompanied by an escort from our team. We will provide a safety briefing discussing some of the construction activities in progress and the safety issues that visitors must be aware of before starting the tour. As we are entering an active jobsite, all safety regulations must be strictly adhered to.

**Safety Equipment:** If you are participating in the tour, we will provide you with a hardhat, safety vest and safety glasses before you go on site.

**Attire:** For safety reasons, full-length pants are required on site. Guests wearing dresses, shorts, capris, skirts or leggings will not be allowed onto the construction site.

**Shoes:** If you are not wearing the appropriate footwear, you will not be allowed onto the construction site. Shoes must be close toed, leather and have a defined heel. Shoes that would fit this description would be hiking boots, leather boots with a low heel, work boots or leather shoes with a defined low heel. For safety reasons, you may not participate in the tour if you are wearing open toed shoes, high heeled shoes/boots, sneakers, sandals, pumps, fashion boots, loafers or any other shoes that are not considered safe for a construction site.

We can accommodate those without proper footwear with a perimeter tour and use the public overlook to view the site. ***See attached for examples of appropriate footwear.***

**Safety Release:** All guests must sign a Construction safety release and waiver of liability before entering the construction site. ***See attached for Construction Site Visit Agreement.***

**Escort:** In order to access the site, all visitors MUST sign a release form and must be accompanied by an escort from the Transbay team. This is an active construction site. As a result, it is of the utmost importance to stay with your escort at all times throughout the tour. When the tour has completed, please check-out with your tour guide in order to ensure that everyone is safe and accounted for. Prior to entering the site, your escort will provide you with a hazard briefing. The briefing will ensure you recognize and avoid hazardous conditions in the construction environment, and will describe measures to reduce and control exposure to hazards.
