

10 Day Look Ahead: Construction Activities Friday, March 9, 2018 through Sunday, March 18, 2018

Fremont Street 2-Lane closure (south of Mission to the Transit Center) Saturday, March 10th: Traffic lanes will be closed Saturday between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM due to underground utility construction. This work is done on weekends due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Minna Street Lane closures (between First and Second Streets) Saturday, March 10th and Saturday, March 17th: Minna Street will be closed and detoured between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM Saturdays due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Natoma Street Lane closures (between First and Fremont Streets) Saturday, March 10th: Natoma Street traffic lanes will be

closed between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM Saturday due to sidewalk replacement and concrete pumping to the Transit Center. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Beale Street 2-Lane closure daily (south of Transit Center to Howard Street) Monday, March 12th through Friday March 16th: Two western traffic lane will be closed Monday through Friday between 7:00 AM and 2:30 PM due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Minna Street Full closure at night (between First and Second Streets) Monday, March 12th through Friday March 16th: Minna Street will be closed and detoured between 7:00 PM - 6:00 AM nightly due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Natoma Street Lane closures (between First and Second Streets) Saturday, March 17th and Sunday, March 18th: Natoma lanes will be closed Saturday and Sunday between 7:00 AM and 6:00 PM due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will be assigned to assist. Local Access will always be available.

What to expect next Weekend Saturday, March 10th and Sunday, March 11th:

Western Transit Center Site (Between First and Second Streets): Construction continues onsite Saturday between 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, work may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Minna Street Lane closures (between First and Second Streets) Saturday, March 10th: Minna Street will be closed and detoured between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM Saturdays due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Central Transit Center Site (Between First and Fremont Streets): Construction continues onsite Saturday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, work may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Fremont Street 2-Lane closure (south of Mission to the Transit Center) Saturday, March 10th: Traffic lanes will be closed Saturday between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM due to underground utility construction. This work is done on weekends due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Natoma Street Lane closures (between First and Fremont Streets) Saturday, March 10th: Natoma Street traffic lanes will be closed between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM Saturday due to sidewalk replacement and concrete pumping to the Transit Center. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Eastern Transit Center Site (Between Fremont and Beale Streets) Construction continues onsite Saturday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, work may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Transit Center Lots under Bus Ramp Viaduct (Harrison to Howard Street): Construction laydown and equipment delivery continue onsite Saturday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, delivery may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Bus Storage Facility (BSF) bounded by Second, Perry, Third, and Stillman streets: Bus Storage Facility Construction continues onsite Saturday between 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Transit Center Project Work: Monday, March 12th through Friday, March 16th:

Western Transit Center Site (Between First and Second Streets): Construction continues daily onsite between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM and nightly onsite between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Occasional material and equipment deliveries will occur between 7:00 PM and 4:30 AM from Minna Street or Natoma Street.



Minna Street Full closure at night (between First and Second Streets) Monday, March 12th through Friday, March 16th: Minna Street will be closed and detoured between 7:00 PM - 6:00 AM nightly due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Central Transit Center Site (Between Fremont and First Streets): Construction continues daily onsite between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM and nightly onsite between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Occasional material and equipment deliveries will occur between 7:00 PM and 4:30 AM from Fremont Street or Natoma Street.

Eastern Transit Center Site (Between Beale and Fremont Streets): Construction continues daily onsite between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM and nightly onsite between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Occasional material and equipment deliveries will occur between 7:00 PM and 4:30 AM from Beale Street.

Beale Street 2-Lane closure daily (south of Transit Center to Howard Street) Monday, March 12th through Friday, March 16th: Two western traffic lane will be closed Monday through Friday between 7:00 AM and 2:30 PM due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

SFMTA/MUNI Overhead Contact System (OCS) system and Traffic Signal system construction: During March and April, the remaining Traffic Signal Poles and the OCS overhead wiring will continue at night with one lane occasionally closed between 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM. This work is scheduled on streets surrounding the Transit Center: Mission Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets), First Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), Fremont Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), and Howard Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets):

Transit Center Lots under Bus Ramp Viaduct (Harrison to Howard Street): These lots are used for Transit Center construction laydown and equipment delivery typically between 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Bus Storage Facility (BSF) bounded by Second, Perry, Third, and Stillman streets:

Construction continues with excavation, grading, rebar, formwork and concrete placement for the bus link ramp daily between 6:00AM and 4:30PM.

What to expect next Weekend Saturday, March 17th and Sunday, March 18th:

Western Transit Center Project Site (Between First and Second Streets): Construction continues onsite Saturday between 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, work may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Minna Street Lane closures (between First and Second Streets) Saturday, March 17th: Minna Street will be closed and detoured between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM Saturdays due to underground utility



construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Natoma Street Lane closures (between First and Second Streets) Saturday, March 17th and Sunday, March 18th: Natoma lanes will be closed Saturday and Sunday between 7:00 AM and 6:00 PM due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will be assigned to assist. Local Access will always be available.

Central Transit Center Project Site (Between First and Fremont Streets): Construction continues onsite Saturday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, work may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Eastern Transit Center Project Site (Between Fremont and Beale Streets) Construction continues onsite Saturday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, work may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Transit Center Lots under Bus Ramp Viaduct (Harrison to Howard Street): Construction laydown and equipment delivery continue onsite Saturday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM. There is no work scheduled for Sunday day shift. However, depending on progress, delivery may occur Sunday 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.


Bus Storage Facility (BSF) bounded by Second, Perry, Third, and Stillman streets: Bus Storage Facility Construction continues onsite Saturday between 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Detours. Street and Sidewalk Closures:

Some surrounding streets in the area may be affected. So you can plan ahead, please review the affected streets below:

SFMTA/MUNI Overhead Contact System (OCS) system and Traffic Signal system construction: During March and April, the remaining Traffic Signal Poles and the OCS overhead wiring will continue at night with one lane occasionally closed between 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM. This work is scheduled on all Streets surrounding the Transit Center: Mission Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets), First Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), Fremont Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), and Howard Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets):

First Street Lane closure at night (between Mission and Howard Streets) Monday, March 12th **through Friday, March 16**th: Overhead ceiling work will occur at night between 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM this week. These rolling lane closures are done at night due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will be assigned to assist. Local Access will always be available.



Fremont Street 2-Lane closure (south of Mission to the Transit Center) Saturday, March 10th: Traffic lanes will be closed Saturday between 7:00 AM - 6:00 PM due to underground utility construction. This work is done on weekends due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Beale Street 2-Lane closure daily (south of Transit Center to Howard Street) Monday, March 12th through Friday, March 16th: Two western traffic lane will be closed Monday through Friday between 7:00 AM and 2:30 PM due to underground utility construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Minna Street (between First and Second Streets) Lane closures and detours: Minna Street traffic lanes will frequently be closed (days or nights) for materials deliveries, construction of underground utilities and reconstruction of roadway and sidewalks. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices, and construction flaggers will be assigned to assist. Local Access will always be available.


