Mission Street (at Beale intersection) Rolling lane closure Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28: There will be a rolling lane closure on Mission Street at the Beale Street intersection Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28 between 7:00AM – 6:00PM due to underground power and traffic signal utility construction crossing Mission Street. Work will include demolition, excavation and road plates. This work is done in accord with SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Fremont Street (south of Mission Street to the Transit Center) 2-Lane closure Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28: Traffic lanes will be closed Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28 between 7:00AM - 6:00PM due to storm drain catch basin and PG&E vault tie-in construction. This work is done on weekends due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

Beale Street (between Mission to Howard Street) 2-Lane closure Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28: Beale Street's two western lanes will be closed Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28 between 7:00AM – 6:00PM due to sewer tie-in construction. 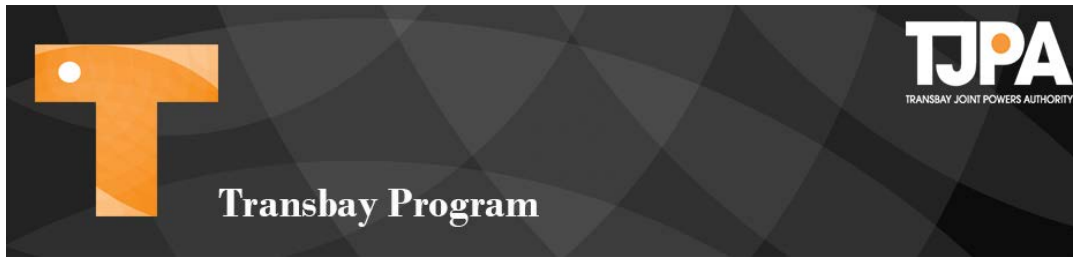

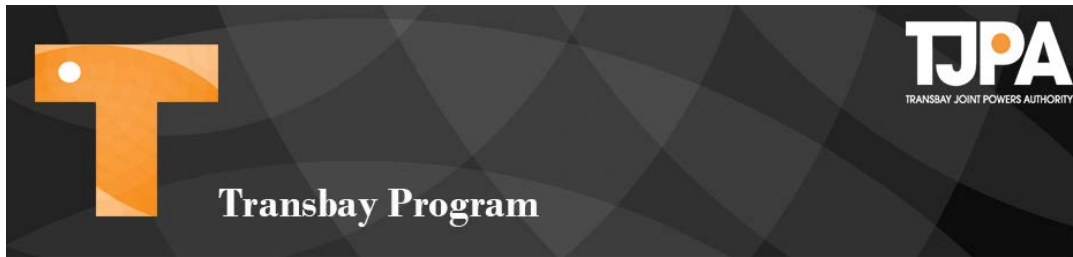

Western Transit Center Site (Between First and Second Streets): Construction continues daily onsite between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM and nightly onsite between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Occasional material and equipment deliveries will occur between 7:00 PM and 4:30 AM from Minna Street or Natoma Street.



Minna Street Night Noise work and closure (between First and Second Streets) Monday April 23 through Friday April 27 and Saturday April 28: Minna Street near Second Street will be closed and detoured between 7:00PM - 6:00AM nightly due to underground utility construction with vehicles entrance and exit from First Street only. This work will include demolition, excavation and road plates, task lighting etc. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available. We apologize for any inconvenience.

First Street Lane closure at night (between Mission and Howard Streets) Monday April 16 through Friday April 20: Overhead work will occur at night between 9:00 PM - 6:00 AM. These rolling lane closures are done at night due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist.

Central Transit Center Site (Between Fremont and First Streets): Construction continues daily onsite between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM and nightly onsite between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Occasional material and equipment deliveries will occur between 7:00 PM and 4:30 AM from Fremont Street or Natoma Street.

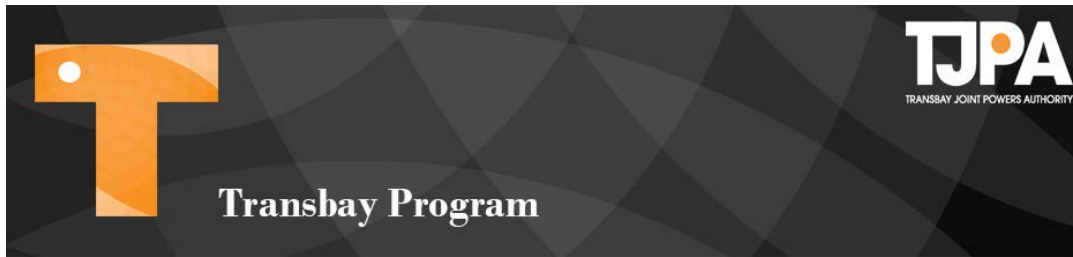
Eastern Transit Center Site (Between Beale and Fremont Streets): Construction continues daily onsite between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM and nightly onsite between 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Occasional material and equipment deliveries will occur between 7:00 PM and 4:30 AM from Beale Street.

Beale Street (between Mission to Howard Street) 2-Lane closure Monday April 23 through Friday April 27: Beale Street's two western lanes will be closed Monday April 23 through Friday April 27 between 7:00AM – 3:30PM due to telecom vault construction. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist. Local Access will always be available.

SFMTA/MUNI Overhead Contact System (OCS) system and Traffic Signal system construction: During April and May, the remaining Traffic Signal Poles and the OCS overhead wiring will continue at night with one lane occasionally closed between 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM. This work is scheduled on streets surrounding the Transit Center: Mission Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets), First Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), Fremont Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), Beale Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), and Howard Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets).

Transit Center Lots under Bus Ramp Viaduct (Harrison to Howard Street): Transit Center construction laydown and equipment delivery will typically between 6:00 AM and 4:30 PM.

Bus Storage Facility (BSF) bounded by Second, Perry, Third, and Stillman streets: Construction continues with excavation, grading, rebar, formwork and concrete placement for the bus link ramp daily between 6:00AM and 4:30PM.

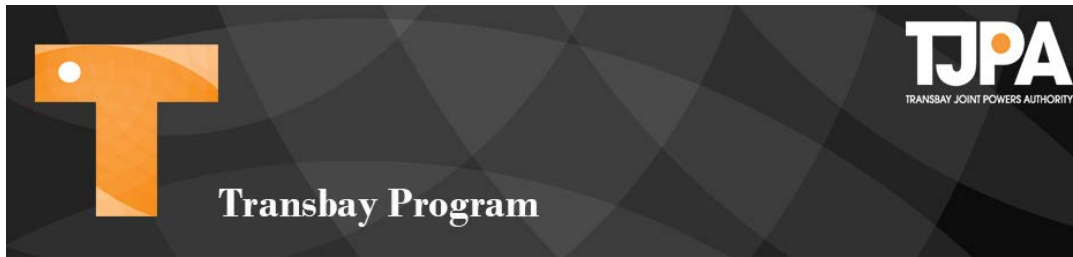

SFMTA/MUNI Overhead Contact System (OCS) system and Traffic Signal system construction:

During April and May, the **remaining Traffic Signal Poles and the OCS** overhead wiring will continue at night with one lane occasionally closed between 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM. This work is scheduled on all Streets surrounding the Transit Center: Mission Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets), First Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), Fremont Street (between



Howard and Mission Streets), Beale Street (between Howard and Mission Streets), and Howard Street (between Fremont and Beale Streets).

Mission Street (at Beale intersection) Rolling lane closure Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28: There will be a rolling lane closure on Mission Street at the Beale Street intersection Saturday April 21 and Saturday April 28 between 7:00AM – 6:00PM due to underground power and traffic signal utility construction crossing Mission Street. Work will include demolition, excavation and road plates. This work is done in accord with SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist. We apologize for any inconvenience.

First Street Lane closure at night (between Mission and Howard Streets) Monday April 23 through Friday April 27: Overhead work will occur at night between 9:00 PM - 6:00 AM. These rolling lane closures are done at night due to SFMTA restrictions. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist.

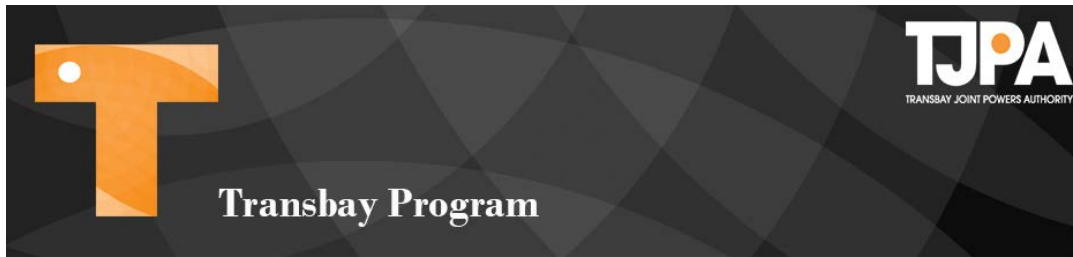

Minna Street (between First and Second Streets) Lane closures and detours: Minna Street traffic lanes will frequently be closed (days or nights) for landscaping materials deliveries to the roof, construction of underground utilities and reconstruction of roadway and sidewalks. Detailed scheduling information and detours for local neighbors will be provided in advance of construction



starting. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will be assigned to assist with traffic and pedestrian impacts. Local Access will always be available.

Natoma Street east (between First and Fremont Streets) Lane closure Saturdays April 21 and April 28: A Traffic lane will be closed Saturdays between 7:00AM and 6:00PM for construction sidewalk replacement and concrete pumping to the Transit Center. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist with traffic and pedestrian impacts. Local Access will always be available.

Natoma Street west (between First and Second Streets) Lane closure Saturdays April 21 and April 28: A Traffic lane will be closed Saturdays between 7:00AM and 6:00PM for construction sidewalk replacement and concrete pumping to the Transit Center. Special Traffic Permits, Traffic control devices and construction flaggers will assist with traffic and pedestrian impacts. Local Access will always be available.

Bus Storage Facility (BSF) bounded by Second, Perry, Third, and Stillman streets: There are no lane closures or detours this week.
