Grease Trap Services (RFP)

SCOPE OF WORK

- Grease Trap Services staff dispatched to perform on-call as needed or job specific proposals need to be experts in their field of work.
- LPC is requesting initial pricing on Grease Traps to be performed every 6 weeks.
- Contractor represents that it will employ skilled, competent, certified (as applicable) and licensed (as applicable) employees to perform the services set forth herein and will provide all manpower required to provide Grease Trap Cleaning and Liquid Waste Pumping and Disposal, as needed.
- LPC is looking for a company that can not only provide Grease Trap Services but a company who can clean and remove 100% of the trap's content.
- Contractor should be capable to dependably and professionally vacuum, pump and dispose of the liquid waste and sludge from a number of liquid waste receptacles and grease traps.
- Grease trap pumping technicians need to clean the entire grease trap and scrape away hardened grease.
- Contractor is responsible to take grease trap and liquid waste to only licensed processing facilities. Contractor to provide LPC or LPC's agent with the proper transport manifests following all federal, state and local regulations.
- Online manifest options for LPC are encouraged but not mandatory
- Fully pump out the exterior grease trap(s)
- Scrape all interior walls of the grease trap and remove the debris and residue, steam clean if applicable.
- In accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, and local ordinances, properly dispose of the grease trap contents.
- Contractors are being requested to perform preventive maintenance every 6 weeks and provide services on an on-call T&M fee basis.

- Contractor will ensure that the work area is kept clean and free of debris, as necessary, to maintain a safe working environment in and around the location. While working on equipment, Contractor agrees to perform services with as little disruption to the site as operationally possible. All tools, equipment and other work materials belonging to the Contractor will be removed from the work location at the end of each working day.
- It is the Contractor's responsibility to make all necessary arrangements with LPC or LPC's agent and local traffic authorities, as applicable, for use of elevators, loading docks, adjacent streets and sidewalks.
- Contractor shall provide dust covers, temporary dust barriers, pads, etc., as required to protect building occupants and contents during its operation.
- Floors, walls, and ceilings of buildings, including elevators, will be adequately protected by Contractor to prevent marring and scratching or other damages.
- Contractor shall keep site clean as work progresses. Upon completion of the work, all surfaces involved in this project shall be clean of any material. Contractor shall remove all waste materials from the work site and dispose of as required to maintain a safe working environment.
