Transbay Transit Center Construction Site Invite

Welcome to the Transbay Transit Center! The construction site is an exciting place to learn about the significant progress that has been made toward completion of the new "Grand Central of the West." Safety is our top priority at all times. Please read the information below and carefully follow all instructions.

Due to safety requirements and capacity limitations, attendance is limited to invited guests only and all visitors must be accompanied by an escort from the Transbay team. We will provide a safety briefing discussing some of the construction activities in progress and the safety issues that visitors must be aware of before starting the tour. As we are entering an active jobsite, all safety regulations must be strictly adhered to.

All visitors must wear appropriate protection when entering our construction site, including hard hats, safety vests and safety glasses.

Location: The briefing will take place at 201 Mission Street, Suite 2100. You will be escorted onto the construction site by a construction tour guide.

Escort: In order to access the site, all visitors MUST sign a release form and must be accompanied by an escort from the Transbay team. This is an active construction site. As a result, it is of the utmost importance to stay with your escort at all times throughout the tour. When the tour has completed, please check-out with your tour guide in order to ensure that everyone is safe and accounted for. Prior to entering the site, your escort will provide you with a hazard briefing. The briefing will ensure you recognize and avoid hazardous conditions in the construction environment, and will describe measures to reduce and control exposure to hazards.

Transportation: Our office is located on the corner of Mission and Beale Street. We encourage guests to walk, bike, take a taxi or take Muni to the event. Our building is centrally located near several transit centers including the Temporary Transbay Terminal and the Embarcadero BART station. Parking: Event parking will **not** be available. Metered street parking is limited in neighboring blocks. Some parking lots and garages are within walking distance.

Attire: For safety reasons, full-length pants are required on site. Guests wearing shorts, capris, skirts or dresses will not be allowed onto the construction site.

Shoes: If you are participating in the tour, you must wear the appropriate shoes. Shoes must be close toed, leather, and have a defined heel. Shoes that would fit this description would be walking shoes, hiking boots or work boots. For safety reasons, you may not participate in the tour if you are wearing open toed shoes, high heeled shoes/boots, sneakers, sandals, pumps, fashion boots, loafers or any other shoes that are not considered safe for walking on a construction site. We can accommodate those without proper footwear with a perimeter tour and use the public overlook to view the site. **See attached for examples of appropriate footwear.**

Safety Equipment: If you are participating in the tour, we will provide you with a hardhat, safety vest and safety glasses before you go on site.

Safety Release: All guests must sign a safety release before entering the construction site –see attached.
