Transit Center Overview



Transbay Joint Powers Authority

- 1999 Proposition H: Extend Caltrain to a new or rebuilt regional transit station on the site of the Transbay Terminal
- Transbay Joint Powers Authority created under State law in April 2001
 - Charged with design, construction and operation of a new Transbay Terminal and associated facilities
- Member agencies
 - City & County of San Francisco
 - Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District
 - Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board
 - City & County of San Francisco
 - San Mateo County Transit/Caltrain
 - Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority
 - California High Speed Rail Authority
 - California Department of Transportation District 4




















Transbay Center Operations & Security






Security Team Composition
