Demolition

- Phase II of the Demolition Contract is approximately 80% complete. This includes:
 - Removal of the existing Bus Deck leading into the east end of the existing Terminal.
 - Removal of the Bus Deck Roof and Walls
 - Removal of the Fremont Street crossing
- Demolition Contractor continues salvage operations inside the existing Terminal.
- Demolition Contractor continues abatement work inside the existing Terminal. Abatement has been completed on the Parcel N Building.
- Archeologist's Work was completed at the west end of the project.




