Exploratory Utility Potholing Work to Take Place on Howard Street

WHAT:	Potholing work on Howard Street at the intersection of Beale Street and the intersection of Main Street, using a jackhammer, air probe and vacuum excavation equipment.
WHEN:	Wednesday, October 14 – Wednesday, October 21 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
WHERE:	Intersection of Howard and Beale Streets. Intersection of Howard and Main Streets.
IMPACTS:	Construction-related noise and possible loss of traffic lanes and on-street parking.
SAFETY:	Please stay clear of jack hammer, vacuum excavation equipment and excavated potholes.

The Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) will undertake exploratory utility potholing work beginning Wednesday, October 14, 2009, and continuing through Wednesday, October 21, 2009, on Howard Street at the intersection of Beale Street and the intersection of Main Street.

The potholing is being conducted to positively identify the location of existing wet utilities to support engineering for the construction of the new Transbay Transit Center.

Hours of potholing will be 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Wednesday through Friday and resuming Monday through Wednesday.

Traffic control, construction equipment and a vacuum excavator truck will be staged along the roadway, and in some cases will temporarily displace on-street parking or require the closure of a traffic lane. Following completion of the potholing work, the holes will be backfilled and repairs will be made to the street surface as consistent with San Francisco Department of Public Works regulations. The long-term use of the street and parking spaces will not be affected.
