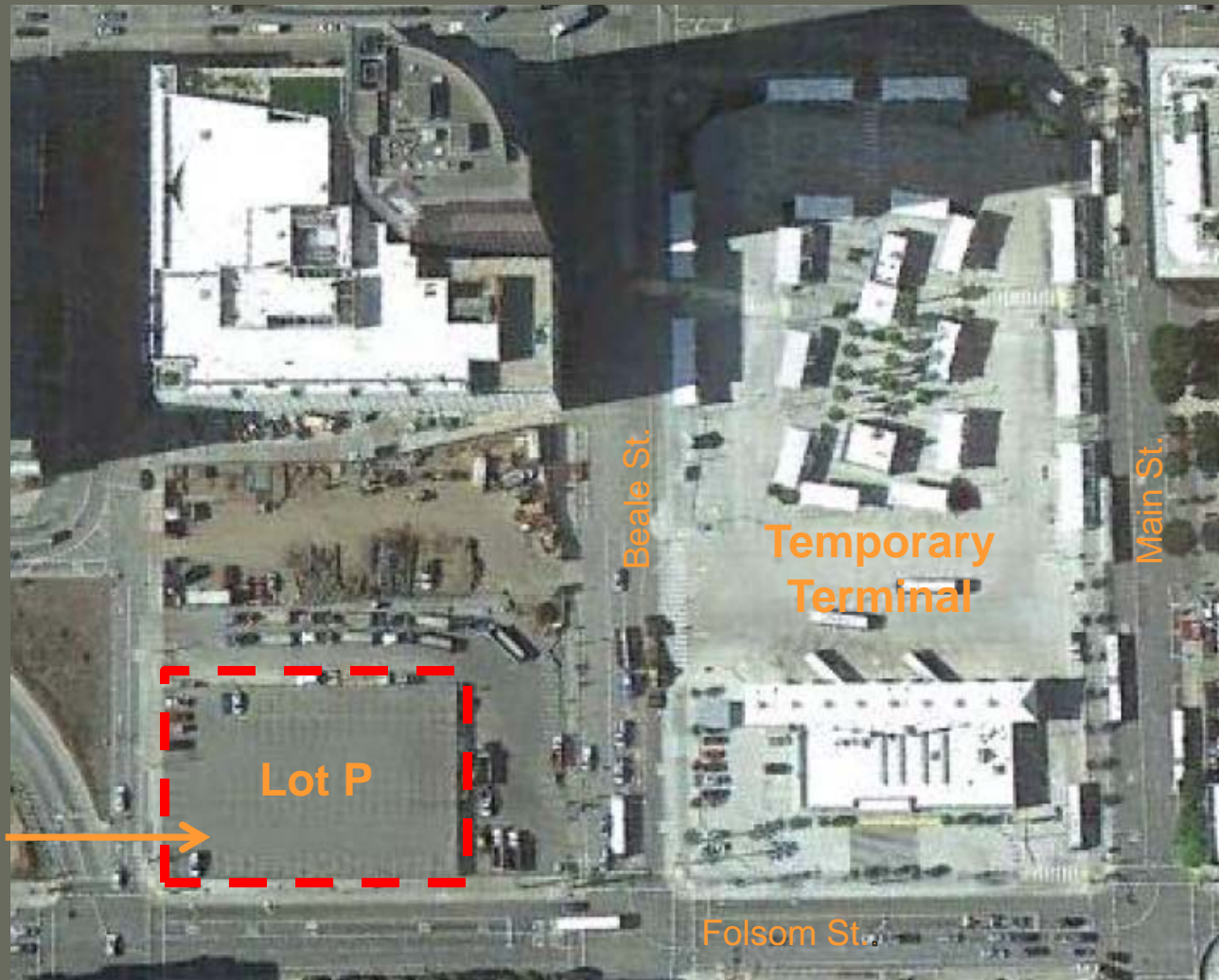

Current Bus Staging



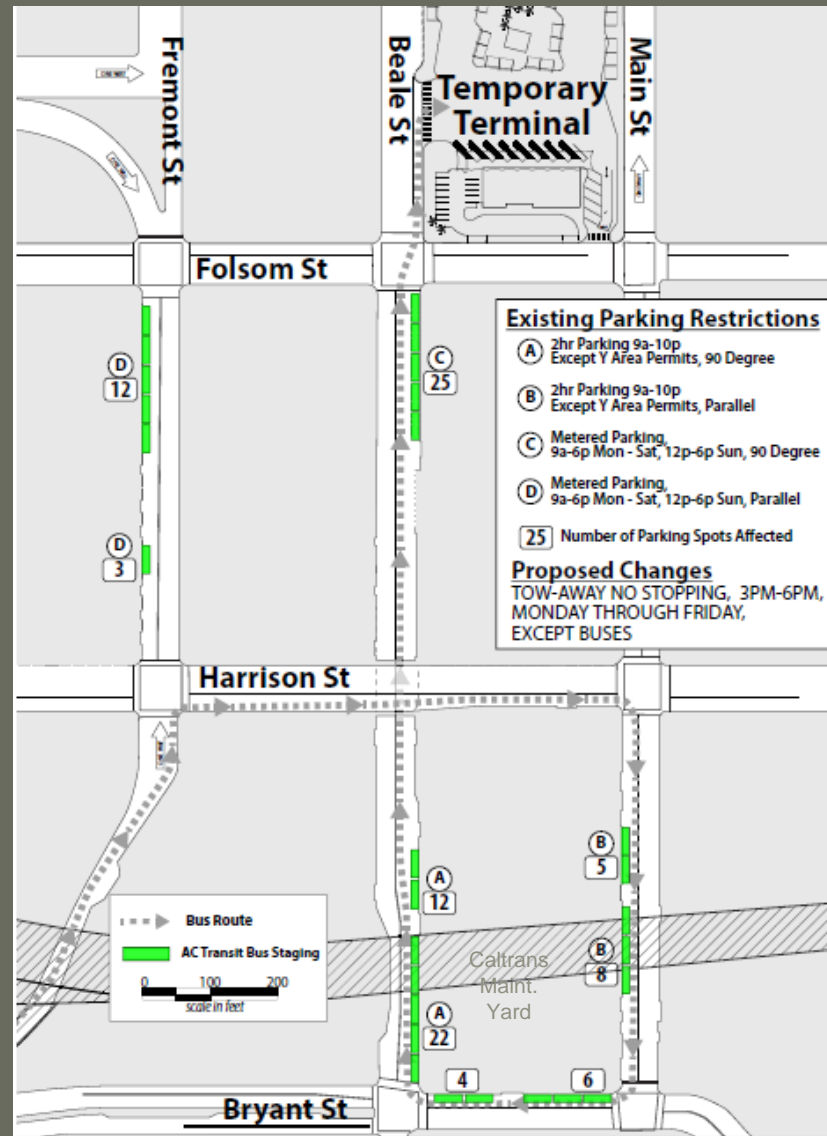
Current AC

(M-F, 3-6pm.)

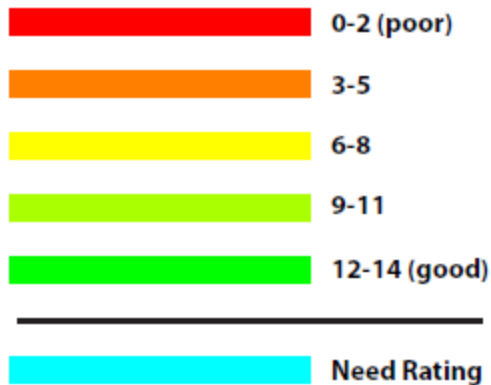

Current Staging Options

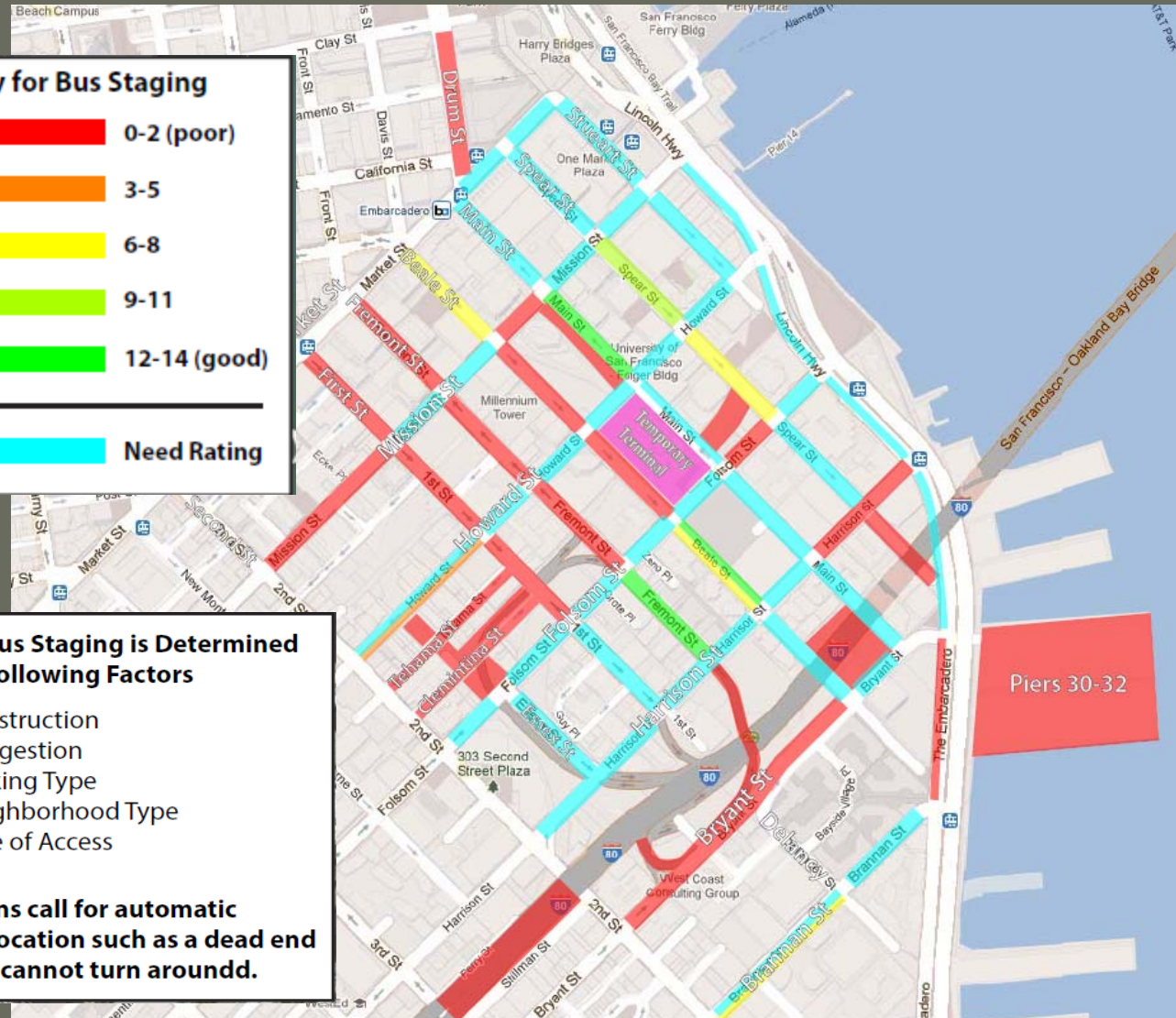
Suitability for Bus Staging



Suitability of Bus Staging is Determined Based on the Following Factors

1. Construction
2. Congestion
3. Parking Type
4. Neighborhood Type
5. Ease of Access

Some conditions call for automatic dismissal of a location such as a dead end because buses cannot turn around.

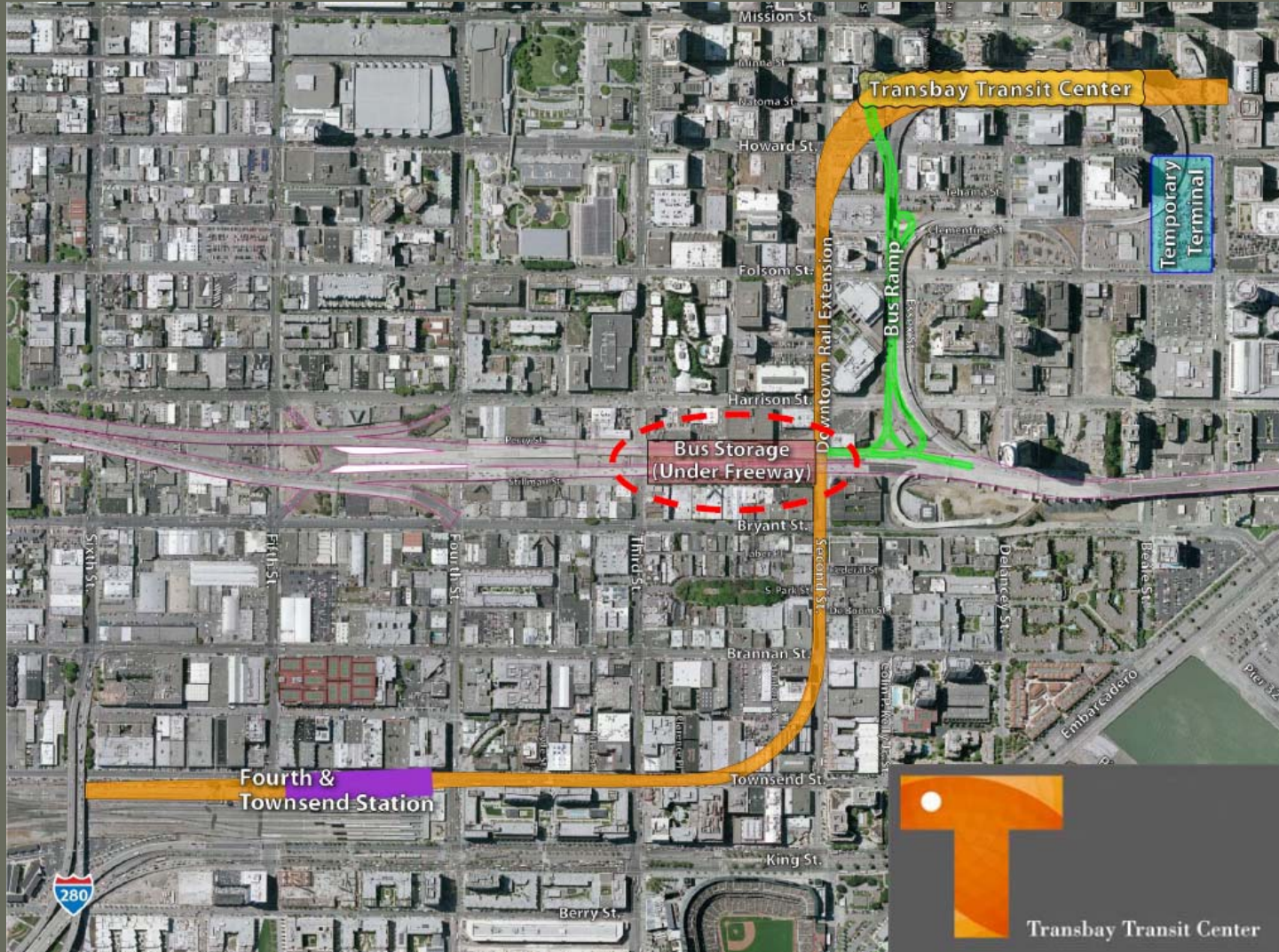
Next Steps

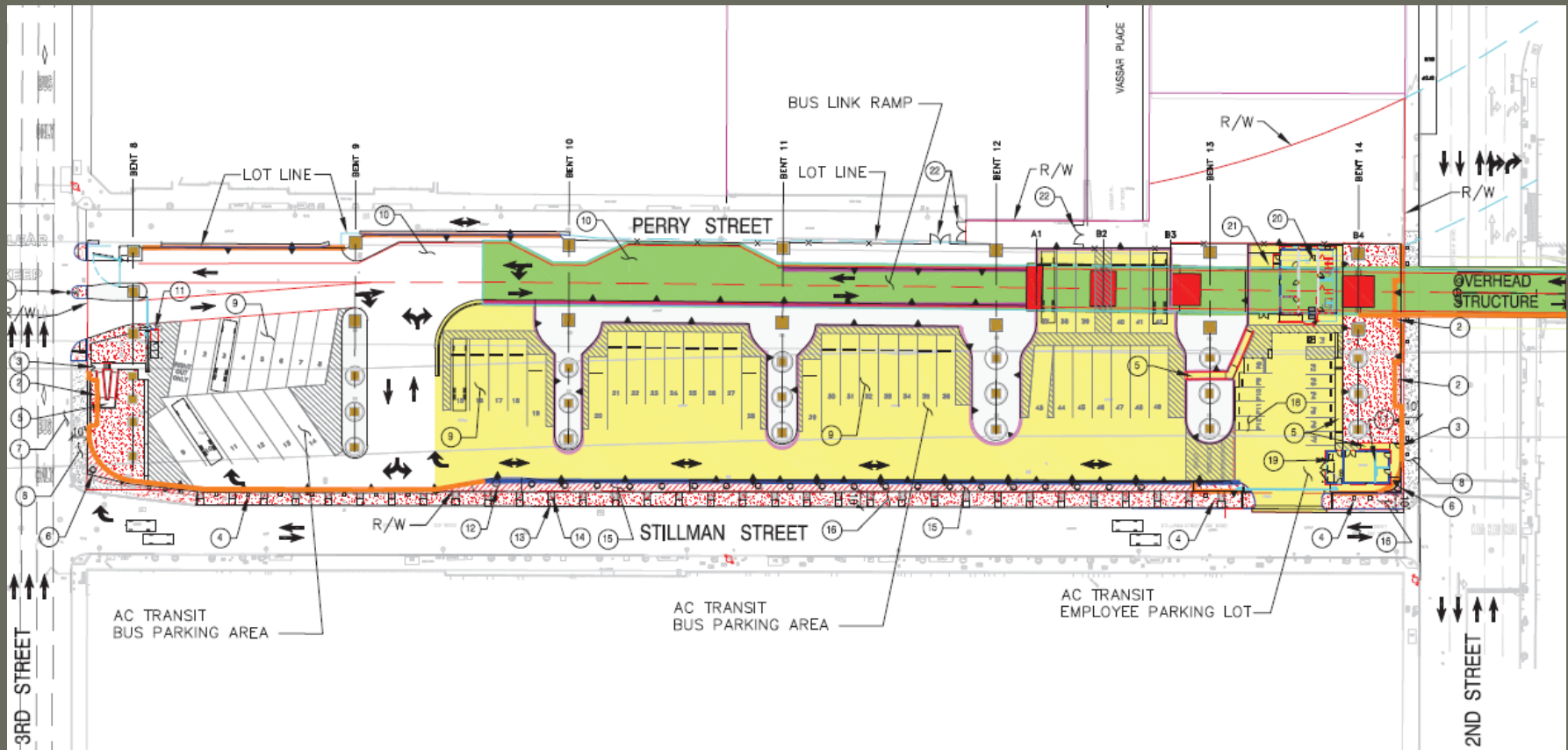

Bus Storage Update

- Caltrans coordination/approval is ongoing:
 - Type Selection approved
 - PSR/PR document approved
 - Fact Sheets submitted for approval
 - Structural Mitigation analysis underway
- SFMTA coordination is ongoing
 - Signal coordination at Third St
 - Second St. clearance under link ramp
- Design Schedule Milestones
 - 65% CD's in June
 - 100% CD's in December
