The following written questions on RFP 19-01 were received by the deadline:

1. Under Section 4.0, Required Skills, Experience and Minimum Qualifications, for the Consultant's Lead Analyst/Project Manager for the first bullet, is the question (underlined text added to ensure our understanding of the meaning): "A minimum of five years' experience in <u>advising senior</u> management positions with public transportation agencies"?

Answer:

Yes, the qualification should read "A minimum of five years' experience in <u>advising</u> <u>senior</u> management positions with public transportation agencies"

2. Under Section 4.0, Required Skills, Experience and Minimum Qualifications, for the Consultant's Lead Analyst/Project Manager for the second bullet, is the question (underlined text added to ensure our understanding of the meaning): "A minimum of ten years' hands-on experience <u>in advising clients on</u> managing federal and state transportation grant programs"?

Answer:

Yes, the qualification should read "A minimum of ten years' hands-on experience <u>in</u> <u>advising clients on</u> managing federal and state transportation grant programs"

3. Section 5.1.2 indicates that the respondent can include brief resumes, which can be shortened as necessary so as not to exceed the page limit. Can the respondent also include long form resumes as an appendix, which would not count against the page limit, for TJPA evaluation committee review?

Answer:

Yes, long resumes may be added as an appendix which would not count against the page limit, for TJPA evaluation committee review
