Key Objectives (2025-2027)




- Focus on advocacy to close funding gap

 - Manage work to durable milestones while seeking future funds




The Portal: 72% Funded

In \$ millions






Master Schedule



Federal

- Secure CRISI program grant and CIG New Starts agreements
- Seek additional competitive grant funds

State

- Prioritize The Portal in Cap-and Trade Program reauthorization
- Include The Portal in capital funding component of 2026 regional transportation measure

Regional

- Elevate The Portal to Level 1 of Major Project Advancement Policy (MAP) Framework
- Reallocate RM3 funds to 40-CT Civil and Tunnel contract (in process)

Local

- Pledge future tax increment revenues
- Extend Transbay CFD and impact fee to the project area


