1. Call to Order

Chair Larkin called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

2. Staff Report (10 minutes)

Lily Madjus Wu, TJPA Communications and Legislative Affairs Director, presented the Staff Report.

Ms. Madjus Wu noted that the January 14^{th} meeting will be rescheduled to occur before the TJPA Board meeting.

3. Approval of Meeting Minutes: November 12, 2024

There was no member of the public wishing to comment. Member Schatmeier motioned to approve the minutes; it was seconded by Member Lavery. A majority voice vote approved the motion. Member Monte abstained.

4. Facility Operations Update (10 minutes)

R.E. Walsh, TJPA Facility Director, presented the item.

Member Schatmeier suggested that when presenting ridership data, we should also note that service quality changes may be a contributor to lower ridership numbers and not just be attributed to the pandemic.

5. The Portal Schedule and Funding Update (15 minutes)

Alfonso Rodriguez, The Portal Project Director, presented the item.

6. Public Comment

Jim Patrick noted that the Grand Hall escalators were out of service, and he shared his experience of inadequate bus departure time signs in the Bus Plaza. He also shared concerns about TJPA's not-to-exceed contracts, where contractors may try to use up their full dollar amounts.

7. CAC Member Comments & Future Agenda Requests

Secretary Larrick noted that Mr. Walsh addressed future agenda request list item 10 on the audible signaling in elevators in his Item 4 presentation, and that it would be removed from the future agenda request list.

Member Munoz requested that the presentation Caltrain gave at a recent open house on Railyards be brought to the CAC. Ms. Madjus Wu stated that there is a plan to have Caltrain present Railyard development plans at the CAC soon.

Future agenda requests include: 1) presentation on train doors and platform heights; 2) San Francisco County Transportation Authority (SFCTA) update on Southeast Railyard Station Study; 3) presentation on the Operating and Maintenance plan for the rail levels of the Transit Center; 4) Small Business and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise commitment for The Portal; 5) presentation on Link21 and effects to The Portal; 6) presentation on Caltrain 4th & Townsend rail yard redevelopment; 7) presentation by SamTrans on their services at the Transit Center; 8) update on upgraded Clipper machines in the Transit Center; 9) presentation by the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) on Bus Plaza bus departure times listed in information displays; and, 10) presentation by San Francisco Mayor's Transportation Advisor on the new administration's transportation priorities.
