Dear Bay Area Residents:

The Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) is soliciting applications from Bay Area residents interested in serving on the TJPA Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC).

The TJPA CAC consists of 15 members representing specific constituencies which reflect the many local and regional groups interested in the Transbay Program.

CAC terms are for a period of two years and each member is eligible to serve a maximum of three consecutive terms.

There are seven (7) full-term (2 year) seats available representing the following constituencies:

- *Local Resident from District 6*
- *Local Business from District 6*
- *Environmental*
- *Bicycle Advocate*
- *Regional Transit Advocate*
- *Member of the City-Wide (San Francisco) Business Community*
- *Member with Expertise in Real Estate Development or Real Estate Finance*

Applicants are encouraged to apply for all seats listed on the application in which they qualify. Members whose terms are expiring have the opportunity to reapply for their current category and/or any categories they fulfill. Staff will review applications and make recommendations to the TJPA Board of Directors.

The TJPA CAC meets on the second Tuesday of the month in the TJPA office at 425 Mission Street, Suite 250, San Francisco, CA. Meetings are from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM. Consistent attendance is required.
